






How do we see our gifts?

Some things we have learned

- No <u>spectators</u>

- Gifts do NOT <u>limit</u> ministries!

1 Peter 4:10-11 As each one has received a special gift, employ it in serving one another as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

What is a spiritual gift?

A <u>spiritual gift</u> is a God-given ability to <u>serve</u> God and other Christians in such a way that Christ is glorified and believers are uplifted.

What is the difference between a talent and a spiritual gift?

A talent is a natural ability to do certain activities, often from birth.

A spiritual gift is given by the Holy Spirit as He desires when we become believers.

What is the difference between a gift, a ministry, and an effect?

1 Corinthians 12:4-6 Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit.

And there are varieties of ministries, and the same Lord.

There are varieties of effects, but the same God who works all things in all persons. NASU

What is the difference between a gift, a ministry, and an effect?

A <u>ministry</u> is the act of serving others. A minister is one who serve others.

An <u>effect</u> is change that occurs when something is done or happens; an event, conditions, or state of affairs that is produced by a cause.

What is the difference between a gift, a ministry, and an effect?

- God, the Father, determines the effects, or plans/purposes to be accomplished.
- **Jesus**, the Son, determines the ministries needed to accomplish the Father's plans.
- The Holy Spirit gifts members of the church body to accomplish the ministries of Jesus to fulfill the Father's will.

But remember, there is only ONE GOD!

But remember, there is only ONE GOD!

Some people know me as an Air Force officer, others don't.

Some people know me as a father, others don't.

Some people know me as a math teacher, others don't.

Some people know me as a pastor, others don't.

Understanding the Trinity is complicated, yet simple, Believe, Trust!

Categories of spiritual gifts:

- 1. No categories. Each gift is seen as separate and not placed in any particular way.
- 2. Two Categories of <u>Speaking</u> gifts and <u>Serving</u> gifts. (1 Peter 4:10)
- 3. Two categories of <u>Motivational</u> gifts and <u>Manifestation</u> gift.

Motivational gifts are given by the Holy Spirit to individuals as He desires. (Romans 12)

Manifestation gifts are used to minister specific needs in specific situations. (1 Cor 12)

The Gifts from Romans 12:1-8

- a. Prophecy,
- b. Service
- c. Teaching
- d. Exhortation
- e. Giving
- f. Leading (Administration, organization)
- g. Mercy



Prophets!

What do you see?

Prophets see things most
Of us do not see.



Who the Prophets are:

People who give <u>inspired</u> delivery of warning, exhortation, instruction, judging, and revealing the secrets of the heart.

People who are gifted to <u>receive</u> and <u>communicate</u> an immediate message of God to Hispeople.

- 1. They speak the truth.
- 2. They proclaim the principles of <u>God</u>
- 3. They <u>cannot</u> be silent in the face of any lie or deceit, or tolerate an error against God's word or His nature.
- 4. They strongly want to see the church back on the right <u>track</u>
- 5. They speak **boldly** in the presence of injustice

Peter is a good example of the gift of prophecy!

Luke 5:4-9 When he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Put out into the deep water and lower your nets for a catch." Simon answered, "Master, we worked hard all night and caught nothing! But at your word I will lower the nets." When they had done this, they caught so many fish that their nets started to tear. So they motioned to their partners in the other boat to come and help them. And they came and filled both boats, so that they were about to sink. But when Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, "Go away from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man!"

Peter is a good example of the gift of prophecy!

Acts 2:14-17 But Peter, taking his stand with the eleven, raised his voice and declared to them: "Men of Judea and all you who live in Jerusalem, let this be known to you and give heed to my words. "For these men are not drunk, as you suppose, for it is only the third hour of the day; but this is what was spoken of through the prophet Joel:

Peter is a good example of the gift of prophecy!

Acts 5:1-6 Now a man named Ananias, together with Sapphira his wife, sold a piece of property. He kept back for himself part of the proceeds with his wife's knowledge; he brought only part of it and placed it at the apostles' feet. But Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit and keep back for yourself part of the proceeds from the sale of the land?

Peter is a good example of the gift of prophecy!

Acts 4:19-21 But Peter and John replied, "Whether it is right before God to obey you rather than God, you decide, for it is impossible for us not to speak about what we have seen and heard."

Some Other Biblical Prophets are...

- 1. John the Baptist (Matthew 21:32; Luke 3:2-20, 7:18-29)
- 2. Anna (Luke 2:36-38)
- 3. Mary (Matthew 1-2, Mark 6:3, Luke 1:26-56)
- 4. Annias (Acts 9:10-17, 22:12-16)
- 5. Hosea (Hosea 1-14)
- 6. Jeremiah (Jeremiah 1-52)
- 7. Isaiah (Isaiah 1-66)
- 8. Jonah (Jonah 1-4)

A good memory verse for Prophets to respond to:

1 Cor 14:3 But the one who prophesies speaks to people for their strengthening, encouragement, and consolation.

Some Characteristics of the Prophet...

- 1. Identifies good and evil, and hates evil
- 2. Sees everything as <u>black</u> <u>and white</u>, no gray or undefined areas
- 3. Perceives the character of individuals or groups
- 4. Encourages <u>repentance</u> that produces a change of heart

- 5. Believes accepting <u>difficulties</u> can produce positive personal growth
- 6. Has only a few or no close personal friends
- 7. Views the <u>Bible</u> as the basis for truth, belief, action, and authority
- 8. Operates on spiritual principles

- 9. Is frank, outspoken, and doesn't mince words
- 10. Grieves deeply over the sin of others
- 11. Is eager to see his or her own <u>blind</u> spots and to help others see theirs too
- 12. Desires to see God's <u>plan</u> worked out in all situations

- 13. Is a very persuasive **speaker**
- 14. <u>Promotes</u> the spiritual growth of groups and individuals
- 15. Is called to intercessory <u>prayer</u>
- 16. Feels the need to verbalize or dramatize what he "sees"

- 17. Tends to be introspective
- 18. Has strong opinions and convictions
- 19. Has strict personal standards
- 20. Desires to be obedient to God at all costs
